
Academic Success

English Language Arts






Success by Student Group


Attendance Rate

Rate at which students are present at school, not including excused or unexcused absences




Chronic Absenteeism

Percentage of students who miss 10% or more of school days per year either with or without a valid excuse





Student Mobility

School Highlights

Academic Courses

Rockland students undergo curriculum based on the Illinois state learning standards in the areas of: English/Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies. Our students also have physical education/health, art, learning center/technology, and music to supplement their core curricular areas. Enrichment is offered 1st-5th and gifted 3rd-5th.

Physical Education, Health and Wellness

Students at Rockland School have physical education three times during the school week. There are daily physical movement times set aside for students to emphasize a physically fit lifestyle. In addition, students have a trimester of specific health instruction taught to them by a certified instructor.

After School Care, Career Education Events, Destination Imagination, Environmental Club, Family Nights, Music Club, Neighborhood Association Partnership, Newspaper, Parent Associations, Reading Clubs, Student Council/Government

School Awards

In 2014 Rockland School was awarded the National Blue Ribbon Award of Excellence from the United States Department of Education. This was the second time that Rockland has achieved this prestigious award.

Career Development Courses and Programs

Rockland School offers "Career Day" to our Kg-5th grade students. During this special day 20+ presenters from our community deliver 5 sessions to our students about their careers. Students are given hands on activities to learn more about these professions that they have signed up for and finish the day with a reflections activity.

Athletics

Rockland students in 4th and 5th grades have the opportunity to participate in a wide variety of intramural offerings including: basketball, soccer, floor hockey and volleyball.

School Personnel Resources

Rockland School is comprised of 39 staff members who help educate our 280 students in grades K-5.

Facilities

In 2018 a new addition was officially opened that included new art and music rooms, a renovation of the office and added security measures, and a full sized gymnasium for all students to appreciate.

School-Level Finance
